Annual Report for Year of 1990

(Pursuant to Section 1901.14, Ohio Revised Code)

This report for 1990 is somewhat slimmer than in previous years. The end of the year saw the Court entering the computer age with a municipal court software system that integrates our various functions and offers increased information. The changeover left no time for some of the manual counting usually included in this report. Next year's report should be bigger and better.

Case filings as reported to the Supreme Court of Ohio are reported on two charts for 1990. One is new filings. The other shows new and reactivated cases. Reactivated criminal cases are those cases which had previously been reported as unavailable. The most frequent reason for unavailability is a warrant for failure to appear. These cases are reactivated when an arrest is made. Reactivated civil cases are those transferred from the small claims docket to the regular docket. The totals are slightly but not significantly higher than those of 1989.

Filings by charge are among the casualties of the conversion but will reappear next year, counted by computer.

In keeping with the community's concern with housing, the Court hired a new deputy bailiff to serve arrest warrants in housing cases. He is also responsible for courtroom security, a growing concern nationwide. This is the first uniformed and armed bailiff that the court has employed.
